## **Funding Update**

- Ph.D. FoTO Recipients
  - FoTO scholarships, tuition award, and insurance posted
  - Disbursement holds
  - Spring 2022 wage position (\$4,344)

- Research Assistants

## **Direct Deposit**

- UAccess Student "Web Refund"

## **Graduate Assistantships (GA)**

## Research Assistant/Associate (RA)

- Requirements:
  - Hired by faculty member per semester or academic year
  - Work: research in lab
  - Minimum 6 units required (includes research units i.e. 599 Ind. Study, 909 MS Report, 910 Thesis or 920 Dissertation)
  - Minimum 3.0 GPA# Hours
- Tips:
  - Do your research and be proactive about contacting professors
  - Monitor email announcements advertising open RA positions
  - Consider all professors you can work with, 100+, including those in other departments
  - · Realize that you are an employee hired under a contract for a specific period
  - Communicate with your superior, including gaining approval in advance for time off



## **Graduate Assistantships (GA)**

### Teaching Assistant/Associate (TA)

- Requirements:
  - Sign up to be considered mid-way through fall and spring. Email call will be sent out.
  - Work: offering teaching support (office hours, grading, lab sessions, discussions)
  - Minimum 6 units required (includes research units i.e. 599 Ind. Study, 909 MS Report, 910 Thesis, 920 Dissertation)
  - Minimum 3.0 GPA# Hours
- Tips:
  - Be sure to monitor email for sign up announcements
  - Academic performance critical factor of TA assignment process
  - Consider contacting other departments to be considered for their TA positions
  - Positive TA evaluations required for possible re-appointment

- FAFSA Application: www.fafsa.gov
- Type of Aid:
  - Federal Unsubsidized Loan (up to \$20,500 per year)
- Eligibility:
  - Graduate student enrolled in at least 5 units
  - U.S. citizen or permanent resident
